OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

INTRODUCTION

Thank you for purchasing Sina product. Please use carefully and in accordance with the instructions. Elegantly designed, your lamp comes complete with:

- 12W LED Energy Saving Bulb
- Silver Finish
- Tilting / Swivel Head with Safety Positioning Pin
- On/Off Switch
- Clip-on Clamp with Adjustable Swing Arm
- Conforms to BS EN safety Standard

CONNECTION TO MAINS

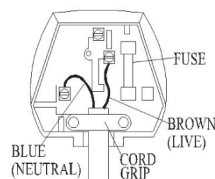
Your unit operates on 100V~240V , 50/60 Hz Mains and comes fitted with a 3-pin BSI Approved plug, so that it is ready for use by simply plugging into AC Mains. Should you need to change or refit a plug, proceed as follows:

IMPORTANT:

The wires in the mains lead are coloured in accordance with the following code:

BLUE : NEUTRAL (N)

BROWN : LIVE (L)



As the colours of the wires in the mains lead of this appliance may not correspond with the coloured markings identifying the terminals in you plug, proceed as follows:

The wire which is coloured **BLUE** must be connected to the terminal which is marked with the letter “**N**” or coloured **BLACK**.

The wire which is coloured **BROWN** must be connected to the terminal which is marked with the letter “**L**” or coloured **RED**.

DO NOT CONNECT EITHER WIRE TO THE EARTH TERMINAL OF A 3-PIN PLUG

Always ensure that the Mains Cord is located into the Plug through the Cord Guard or Cable Clamp, (see figure 1, Plug Wiring diagram above), and that the Cord Guard screws are tightened to clamp the Cord (outer sheath and inner coloured wires) in position in the Plug. Make sure the Plug top is also fitted securely.

This appliance must be protected by a 3-Amp fuse in a 13-amp type (BS1363) plug. Should you need to replace the fuse, use only an ASTA approved BS1362 fuse.

TO OPERATE

Screw in a 5 W (Max) LED Energy Saving Bulb into the bulb holder, located in the lampshade, then simply plug the fitted plug into any households AC Mains outlet and operate via the On/Off switch.

MINIMUM DISTANCES – LAMP TO OTHER SURFACES

As shown in figure 2 below, the minimum distance from any object when illuminated should be 0.3 metres.

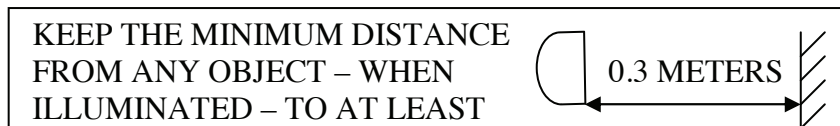

IMPORTANT

1. Your Table Lamp is intended for household use only.
2. Do not use it in damp or wet areas, or in the bathroom or outdoors.
3. Do not use a bulb of higher voltage than that rated, i.e. 20W Max.
4. Do not use incandescent bulbs in this unit.
5. Should you need to replace a bulb, allow sufficient time for the bulb and lampshade assembly to cool before proceeding to do so.
6. Never touch the bare bulb with your bare fingers or hands.
7. Grease or oil from fingers can damage the bulb and cause the bulb to burn out, or drastically reduce its operating life.
8. Instead, always use a soft cloth or facial tissue when handling the bulb.
9. If grease or dirt is seen to get onto the bulb, carefully wipe clean with a lint-free cloth moistened with methylated spirit.
10. If the mains cord of this luminaire is damaged, it should be replaced by the manufacturer or a similar qualified person in order to avoid hazard.
