SAFETY OF USE:

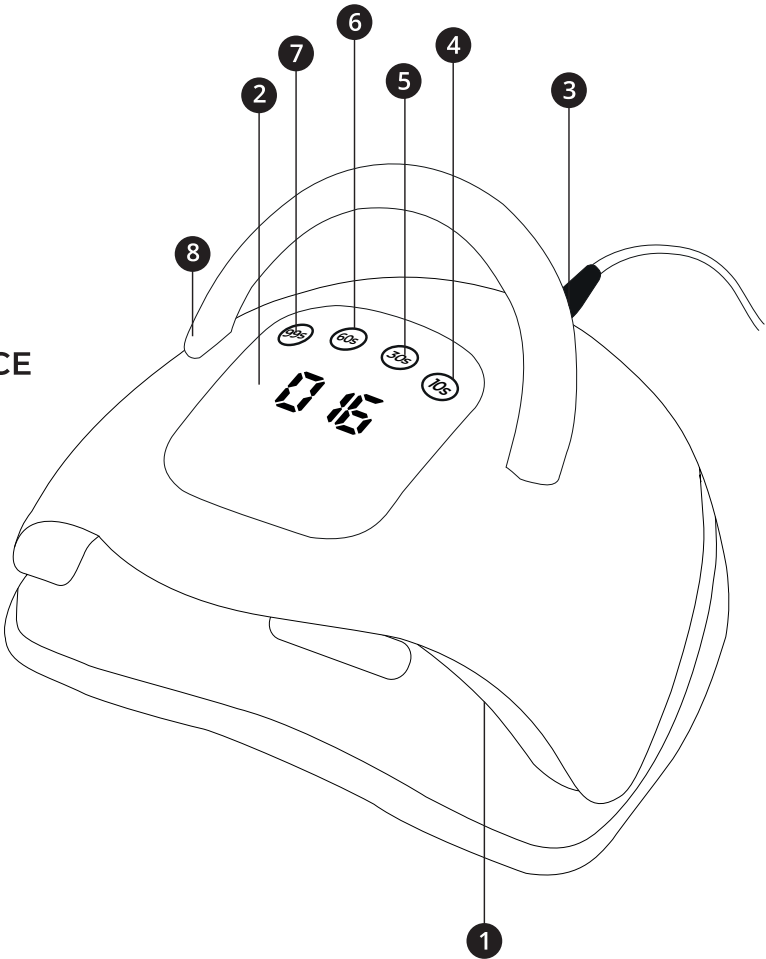
1. Carefully read the operating manual before use.
2. The lamp should only be powered by a suitable power source.
3. Protect the device from dust, water, and other liquids.
4. Unplug the lamp from the power source when not in use or when cleaning is required.
5. Do not use the lamp:
 - In humid environments.
 - If the power adapter is damaged.
 - If the lamp or the connection cable is damaged.
 - If the timer buttons do not function properly.
6. The device is intended for indoor use only.
7. Please note that making self-switches and changes to your device is prohibited and equivalent to the loss of warranty.
8. Do not stare directly into the LED diodes to avoid potential eye damage.
9. Keep out of reach of children.

3. CHARACTERISTICS OF THE DEVICE AND THE FUNCTION BUTTONS:

1. Motion sensor
2. LCD display
3. Power input port
4. 10s timer button
5. 30s timer button
6. 60s timer button
7. 99s timer button (Low Heat Mode)
8. Foldable handle



4. HOW TO USE:

1. Connect the device to the adapter, then to the power source.
2. select one of the four timer modes: 10s / 30s / 60s / 99s (99s is the Low Heat Mode - gradual power increase recommended for sensitive nail plates and builder gels).
3. Thanks to the motion sensor, the lamp can be activated without pressing the timer buttons. Place your hand inside the lamp, and the sensor will automatically start the light. The maximum working time is 120 seconds. The time counts down.
4. Removing your hand will automatically turn off the lamp.
5. When the preset time is counting down, you can press the timer button again to reset the time and switch to standby mode.
6. Follow the curing instructions of the product you are using.
7. After completing use, unplug the lamp from the power source.
