1. SAFETY OF USE:

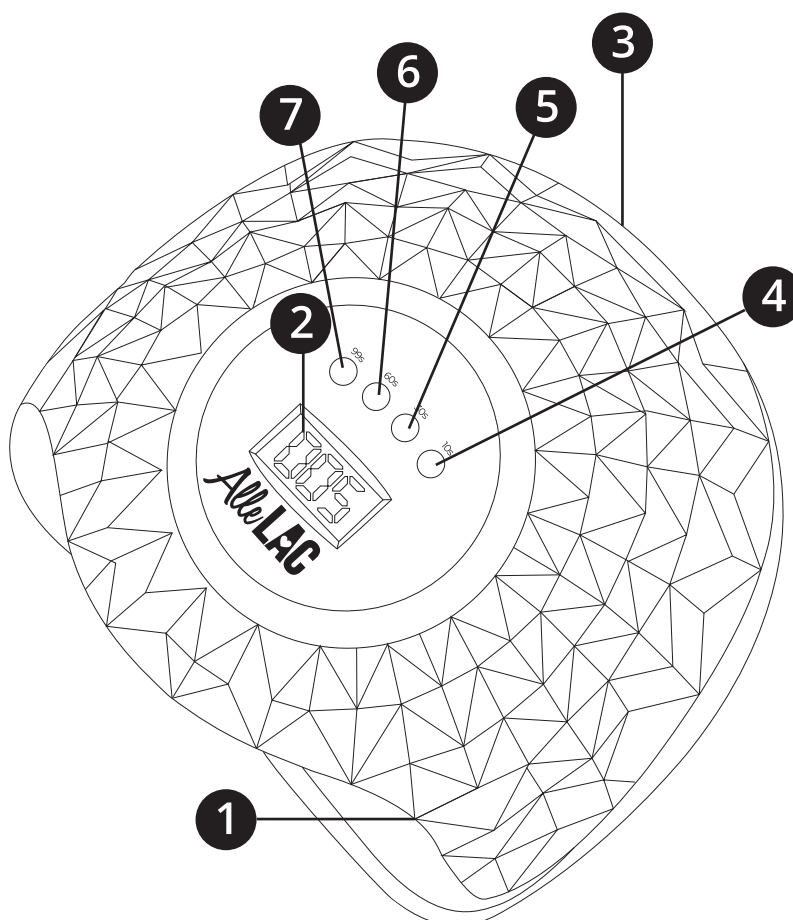
1. Read the user manual carefully before use.
2. Ensure that the actual operating voltage corresponds to the lamp's specifications.
3. Do not allow the device to become wet, do not immerse or spill any liquids inside the device to avoid damage, short circuit, or electric shock.
4. Do not use the lamp if the power cable or timer buttons are damaged.
5. The device is intended for indoor use only.
6. If you are not using the device for an extended period, unplug it from the power outlet.
7. Any self-made modifications or changes to the device are strictly prohibited and will void the warranty.
8. Do not look directly at the LED bulbs, as it may cause eye damage.
9. Keep the device out of reach of children.

3. DEVICE FEATURES AND FUNCTION BUTTONS:

1. Motion sensor
2. LCD display
3. Power cable input socket
4. 10s timer button
5. 30s timer button
6. 60s timer button
7. 99s timer button (Low Heat Mode)



4. HOW TO USE:

1. Connect the adapter, then plug into the power supply.
2. The timer includes the following modes: 10s / 30s / 60s / 99s (99s is the Low Heat Mode).
3. If you do not press any timer button after turning on the lamp, inserting your hand into the lamp will activate the infrared sensor and automatically start the lamp. The maximum working time is 120 seconds.
4. When the device counts down the set time, you can press the timer button again to reset the time and switch the lamp to standby mode.
5. Press the 99s timer button - the lamp will enter Low Heat Mode, and the light output will gradually increase.
6. Follow the curing instructions of the selected product.
7. If you are not using the lamp, unplug it from the power supply.
